

Hydrostatic Pressure: A Homeowner Warning-Sign Checklist

What you see and what it may mean

Water seeps in where the floor meets the wall

Classic pressure sign - water is being pushed up under the slab

Seepage gets worse during or after heavy rain

Soil is saturating and pressure is spiking - track the timing

A horizontal crack runs along a foundation wall

Possible pressure on the wall - have it inspected soon

The basement floor has cracked or heaved

Uplift pressure may be lifting the slab - book an assessment

Walls feel damp or bow inward slightly

Sustained pressure load - do not delay a professional look

Sump pit fills fast and often

High groundwater around the home - confirm backup pump and drainage
